



## Message from the Director

Excellencies and distinguished guests,

I am Professor Eun Gu Lee, and I am the current Director of the Center for Critical Foreign Languages Education at Hankuk University of Foreign Studies.

The Center for Critical Foreign Languages Education was established to build a platform of critical foreign language education in accordance with the purpose of the Act on the Promotion of Education of Critical Foreign Languages (Feb. 3, 2016). The Act aims to provide various and specialized educational opportunities to people who wish to learn Critical Foreign Languages (CFL) in Korea and contribute to the enhancement of national competitiveness by nurturing the talent and skill of communicating in critical foreign languages.

In 2018, Hankuk University of Foreign Studies was designated as a specialized educational institution for the promotion of critical foreign language education by the National Institute of International Education under the Ministry of Education. As a result, the Center for Critical Foreign Languages Education has actively been encouraging programs related to critical foreign languages in order to nurture professional manpower/competent personnel equipped with a command of critical foreign languages, as well as for expanding their knowledge-base, and not only building the learning infrastructure and developing critical foreign languages education, but also providing educational opportunities to citizens wishing to learn CFL. Following the first phase last year (15 languages), 20 languages have been selected in Phase 2 of the Critical Foreign Languages Program. Further, our Center currently offers 16 language programs among all of these. HUFS is the largest university for foreign studies not only in Korea but also in Asia, currently offering 45 language courses. Consequently, our Center has a great capacity to incorporate more languages programs. In particular, from the position of Korea which is an export-based economy, nurturing regional experts based on foreign languages is directly related to the future competitiveness of the country. Furthermore, the importance of critical foreign languages is being emphasized even in the private sector which wishes to conduct business in relevant regions.

While the 4<sup>th</sup> Industrial Revolution has rapidly transformed the global landscape, overseas markets have increasingly diversified. Against this backdrop, I believe foreign languages are no longer mere communication tools but strategic assets that promote national interests and security. In this vein, critical foreign languages education should be viewed as a major national strategy in global communication. Learning a foreign language is a process of understanding the culture from a relative perspective, starting with interest and love/attention for the country. Therefore, I believe that an understanding of language and culture will bring about a world in which mutual understanding and cooperation are promoted. In this sense, this forum, which features ambassadors from 13 countries, will be an important communications platform in our journey towards the destination envisioned by the Act on the Promotion of Critical Foreign Languages Education. Moreover, I believe the CFL Ambassador Forum will create an opportunity for Korea to cooperate with relevant partners across national borders and promote critical foreign languages education domestically. I hope that this forum, by extension, will be a meaningful venue for all of us to reevaluate and re-examine the role and value of critical foreign languages in the development of relations between Korea and other relevant countries.

Hopefully, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Ambassador Forum will be a great wonderful platform that promotes active exchanges between institutions, universities, and countries. Last but not least, I would like to express my deepest gratitude to all the distinguished guests attending today's forum and all those who are attending in person.
