



## **Application Guideline:**

### **1. Program Outline**

CAP in Hawai'i 2021 will be held online. Participants will gather online and the program will be conducted by lectures of the University of Hawai'i, Manoa. Based on PBL (Problem Based Learning) / TBL (Team Based Learning) method, the program will encourage the participants to seek solutions to common problems faced by countries in the Asia Pacific region through active discussion with university students from Japan and Hawaii.

### **2. Program Period**

Tuesday, February 23, 2021 to Saturday, March 6, 2021 (10 days lecture)

※ Classes will be conducted Tuesday through Saturday, except Sunday and Monday in Japan time. \*The timetable will be provided as soon as it is finalized.

### **3. Program Fees**

Participants from foreign universities must pay tuition fee JPY29,600 for Kyushu University and program fee USD950 for the University of Hawai'i, Manoa by designated deadline.

### **4. Scholarships**

Kyushu university offers a limited number of scholarships to selected students who are potentially contribute to multicultural dynamics in and outside of this program.

The program fee (USD950) will be covered by the scholarship (no need to remit upfront)

Selected students must remit the tuition fee (JPY29,600) for Kyushu University by the due date.

The scholarship (JPY29,600) will be remitted to a recipient by overseas remittance.

- Please check the transfer fee in advance and make sure you do not over or under transfer. Please note that any amount transferred in excess will not be refunded.
